Please keep in mind that individuals under the age of 5 are unable to be tested. Minors under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian with them in order to be tested. Currently, ID and/or your insurance card is **NOT** required in order to be tested.

Pre-registering for a testing site speeds up the wait time when you arrive at a site as well as increases the accuracy of demographic information and getting results back to you.
