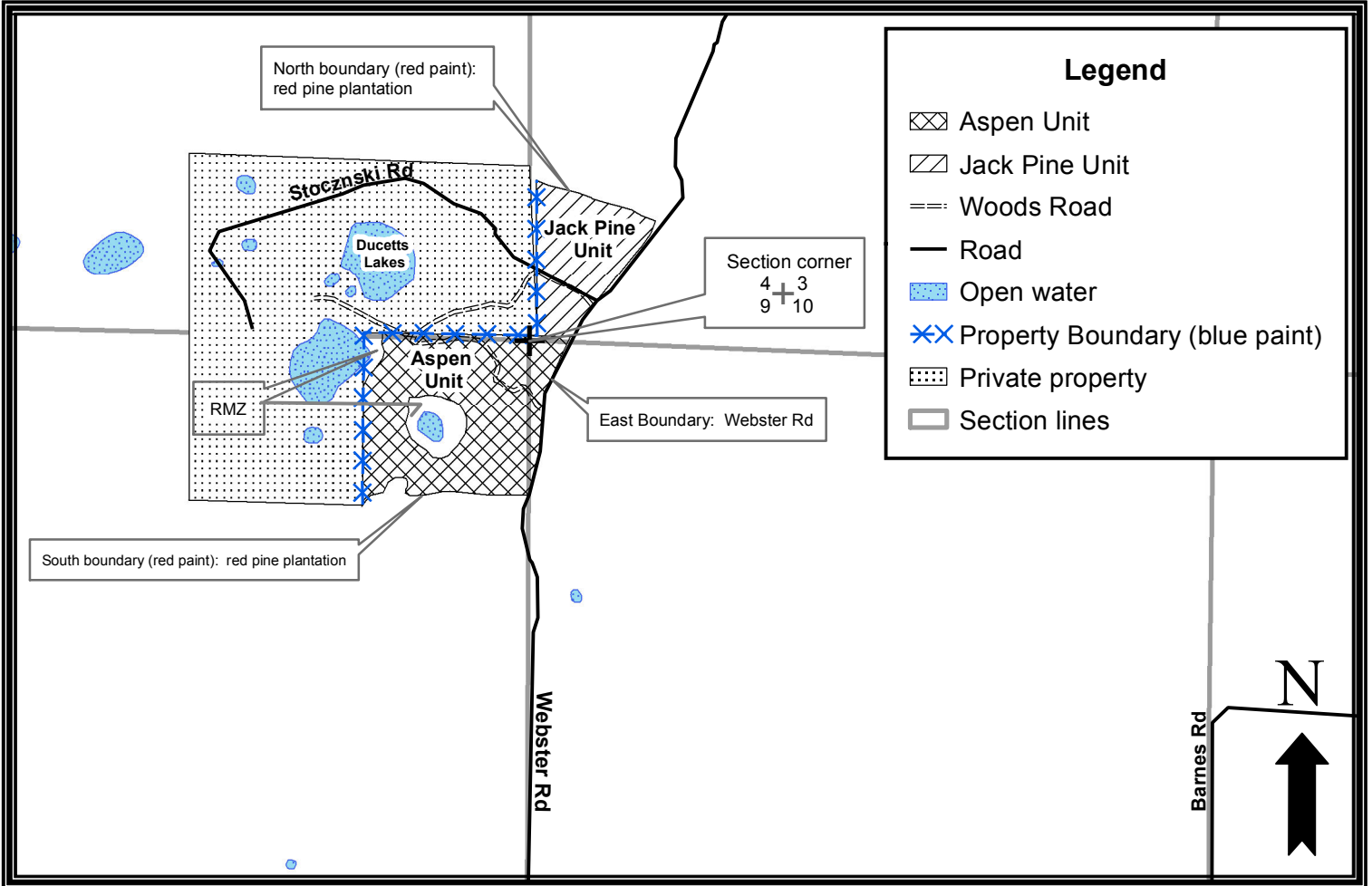

## Harvest requirements:

- Sale is being sold on a ticket scale basis. Whole-tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will not be allowed.
- Sale boundaries and internal boundaries consist of red paint lines, Webster Road (east), and blue line along the west and north property boundaries.
- **Aspen and Jack pine unit:** Cut all jack pine, red pine, and hardwood stems 2" DBH and greater.
- **Aspen unit:** Leave all conifer (except jack pine and red pine). **Jack pine unit:** Harvest all trees 2" DBH and greater.
- **Aspen unit:** Retain all snags that do not pose a direct safety hazard to logging operations. **Jack pine unit:** Remove all snags for site preparation/planting purposes.
- Prior to moving equipment to and from the sale area, scrape soil and debris from exterior surfaces.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction, and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>.
