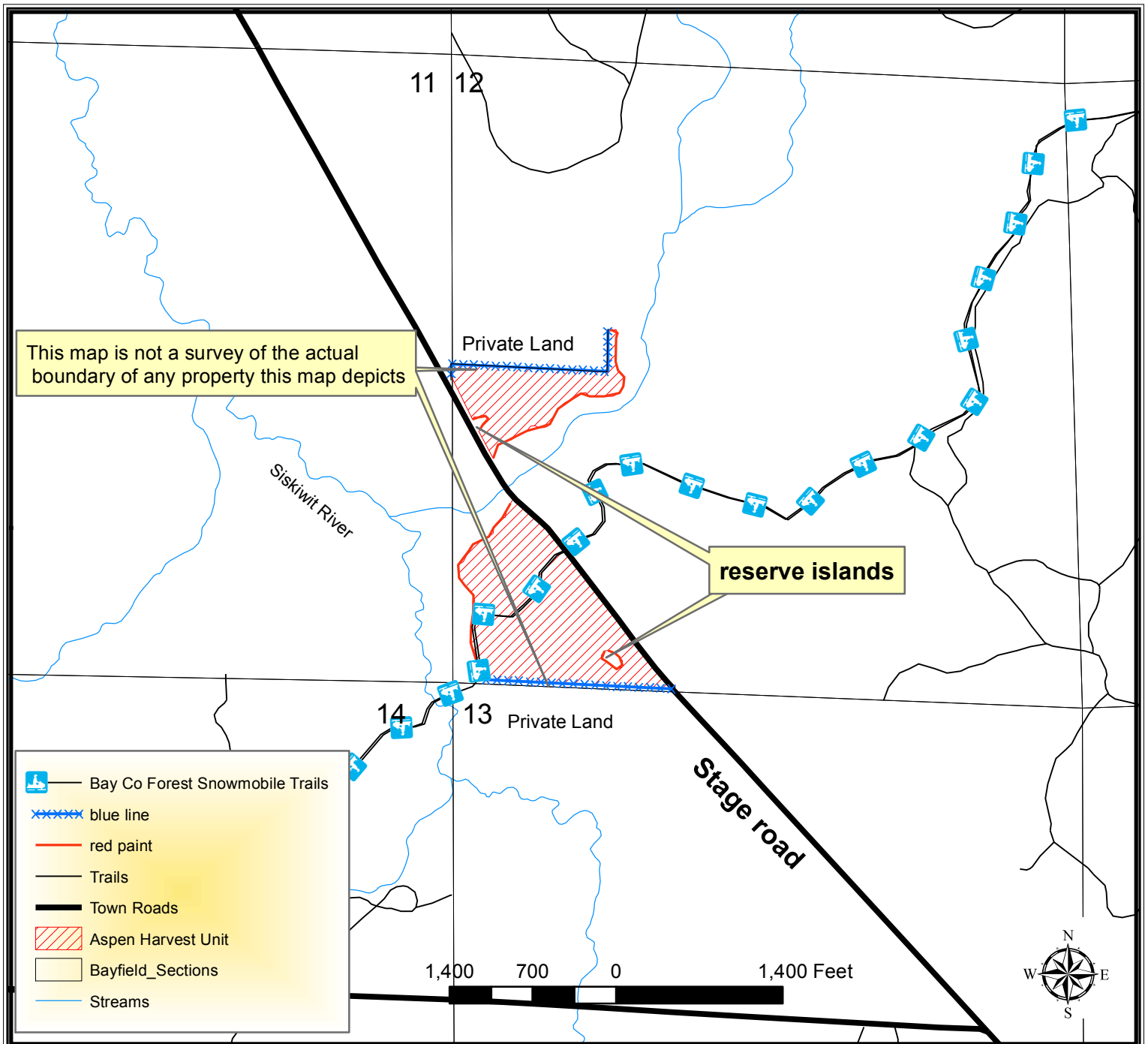

TRACT 08-18 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. Harvest unit 1 has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft².

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

1. In Unit 1, harvest all hardwood stems 2" and greater. Leave all oak.
2. In Unit 1, harvest all balsam fir and spruce stems 4" and greater

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

1. If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
2. Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen or during dry conditions as determined by Bayfield County.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

1. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
2. Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

E. OTHER:

1. No equipment or trees may cross the blue paint lines. On the southern blue line there is a mowed game opening near the line that is on county forest with timber on the south side of that opening that needs to be cut along the blue line.
2. This sale includes 2 trees that are painted with a purple 'X'. Operator must fell and leave all trees marked with a purple "X". "X" marked trees should be cut just above the purple ring and should lie as close to the high stump as possible. These trees will create ruffed grouse drumming habitat.
3. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
