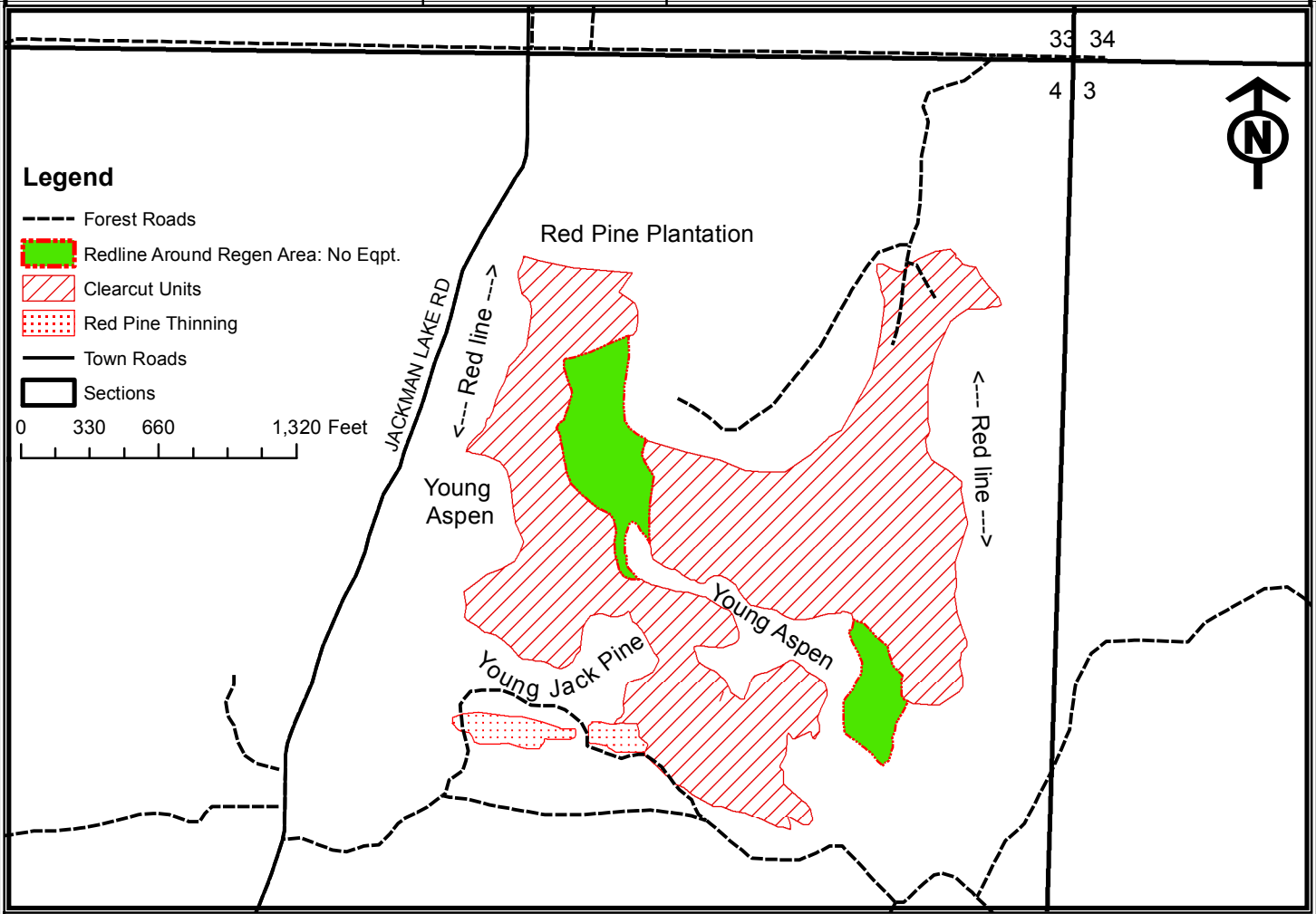

Harvest Requirements:

This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.

- This 71-acre sale includes 4 units and is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- External sale boundaries are formed by red line and obvious changes in timber types. Two areas of white pine regeneration have been excluded from the sale and marked with red paint. No equipment may operate within these areas.
- **Prescription for ALL Units:** Cut all hardwoods $\geq 2''$ and all jack pine $\geq 5''$ in diameter. Harvest all orange-marked red and white pine. Leave all unmarked red pine, white pine, balsam fir, and spruce.
- Sale is on biomass restricted soils. Whole-tree harvesting is not permitted.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than 3 weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
