
## **Bayfield County Forestry & Parks Department**



## Harvest Requirements:

- > Sale is being sold on a ticket scale basis.
- > Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, noticeable change in timber type, and roads.
- > Jack Pine Clearcut: Harvest all merchantable timber and sever all non-merchantable stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Aspen Clearcut: Leave all white pine and harvest all other conifer. Harvest all merchantable hardwood stems and sever all hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- ➤ Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1 st to August 31 st.
- ➤ Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- > Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- ➤ Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will not be allowed.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
