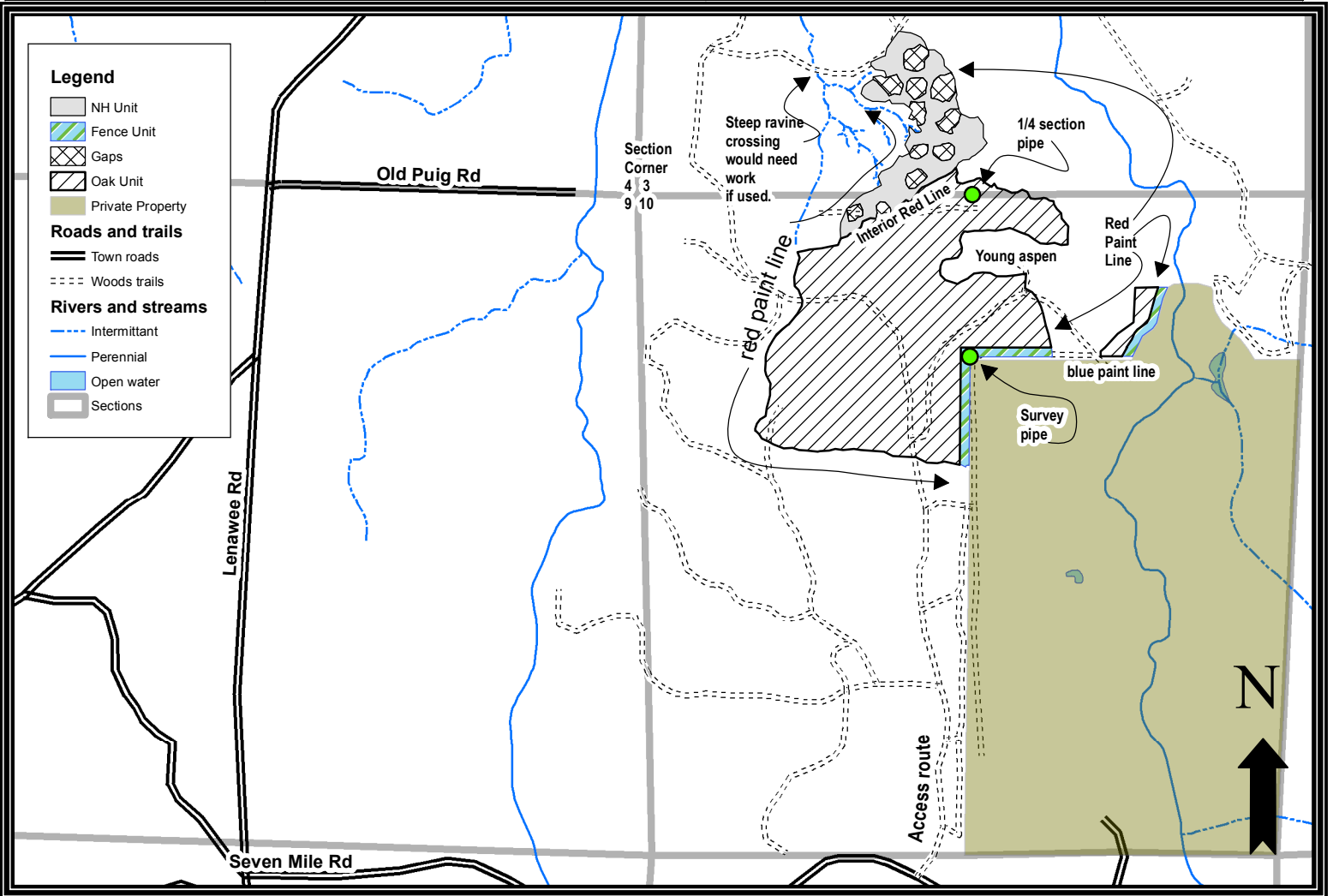

Harvest requirements:

- This is a ticket sale.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation
- This harvest is in three units.
 - NH unit: North of the interior red line, harvest in FROZEN SEASON ONLY. Harvest all trees 2" diameter and larger inside purple-marked gaps. Gaps are indicated by purple paint on 8 to 10 perimeter trees. Two purple dots are painted to face into each gap, and a purple slash is on the back of each perimeter tree.
 - Oak unit: South of the interior red line, cut all trees 2" diameter and larger EXCEPT:
 - do not cut or damage non-merchantable red pine,
 - do not cut or damage white pine of any size, and
 - do not cut purple-marked trees.
 - Fence-line Unit: Cut all trees 2 inches diameter and larger within 66 feet of the fence bordering the sale area.
- Prior to moving equipment on to or off the sale area, scrape or brush debris and soil from exterior surfaces.
- All roads are in place. This contract requires county authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission of Bayfield County.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- Property lines depicted on this map are approximate and do not constitute a survey.
