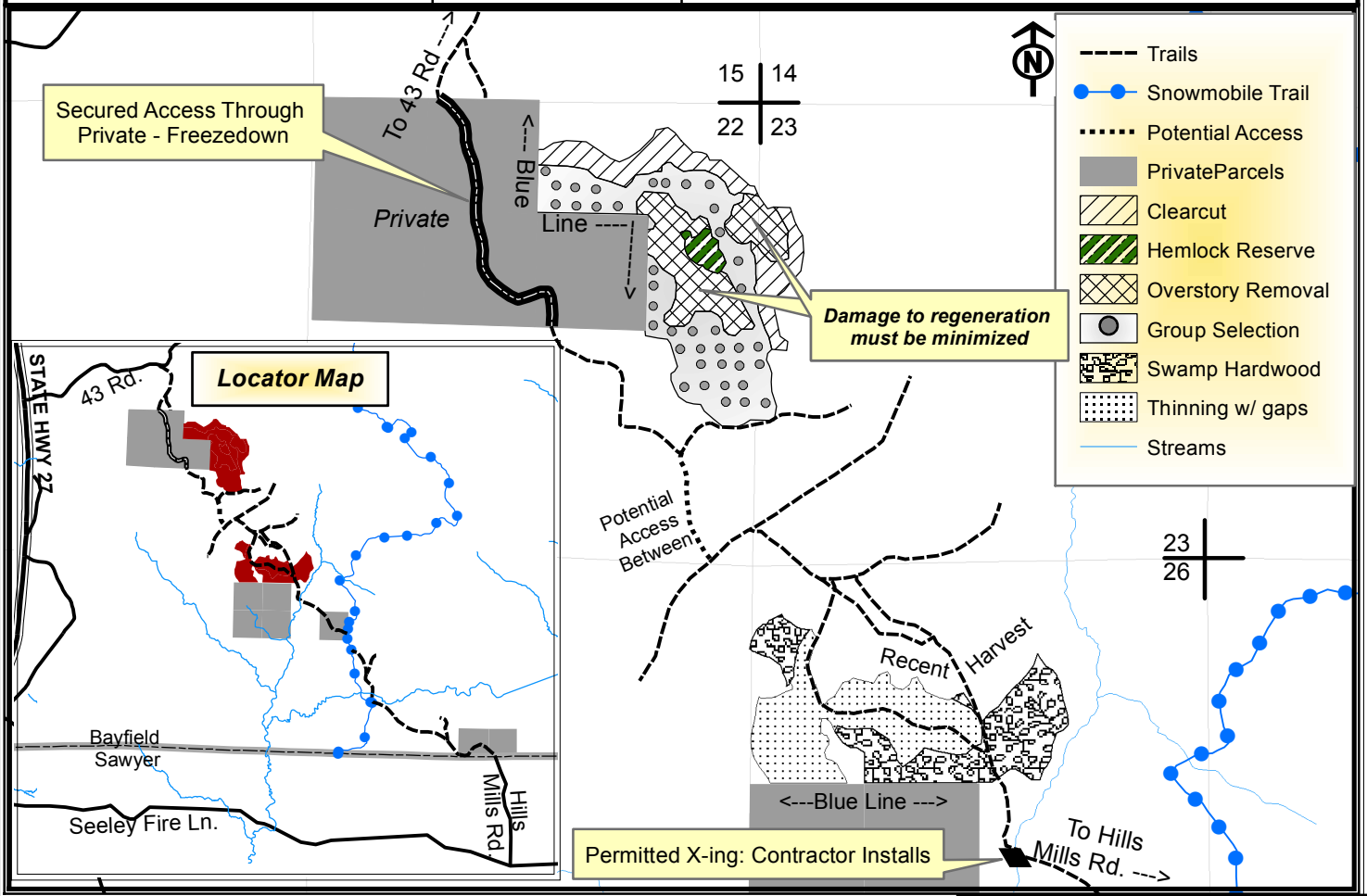

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale operations may only occur when ground is frozen.
- There is secured access through private from both directions (to 43 Rd. or to Hills Mills Rd.) Bayfield County has secured a temporary stream crossing permit over Hills Mills Creek. Contractor will install and remove crane mats at crossing according to DNR specifications. Contact County for details.
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line (around and between all units on north portion), blue paint line, or a change in timber type.
- The blue paint line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
- Group Selection Unit: There are purple painted canopy gaps (6-8 two dot purple painted trees on perimeter facing inward) HARVEST ALL merchantable trees and sever all >1" diameter within the purple painted canopy gaps. LEAVE ALL purple marked trees and all conifers.
- Clearcut Unit: Harvest all stems > 2" in diameter EXCEPT conifers, green painted trees, and yellow birch under 8" in diameter.
- Overstory Removal Unit: Harvest all merchantable stems EXCEPT conifers and green painted trees. The point of this harvest is to release young saplings that are present in the understory. **Minimize damage to the regeneration.**
- Thinning w/ Gaps Unit: Harvest all orange marked trees and harvest all aspen. There are green painted canopy gaps (6-8 two dot green painted trees on perimeter facing in towards the gap) that are approximately 60 feet in diameter. Harvest or sever all stems 1" in diameter and larger within the gaps.
- Swamp Hardwood Unit: Leave all conifer, oak, and green painted trees. Harvest or sever all other stems 2" and greater.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
