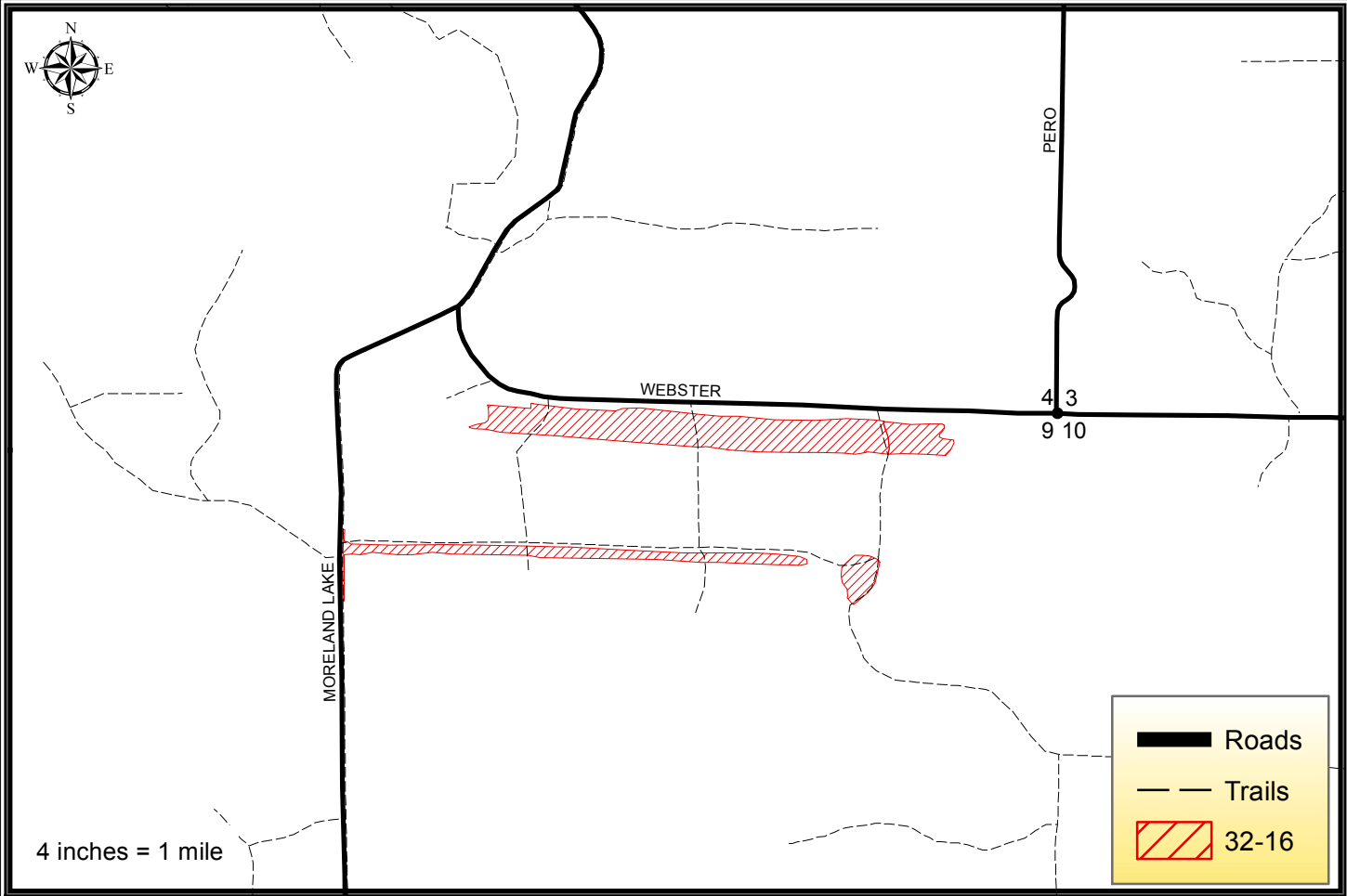

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a red pine thinning being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries consist of roads or the edges of the plantation (No more orange marked trees).
- Harvest all orange marked trees.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- This sale is restricted to short wood logging. Bayfield County may, at its discretion allow pole skidding if the purchaser can demonstrate that it can be done without causing damage to the residual stand.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- Moreland Lake Road is snowmobile route. If the sale is harvested during frozen ground conditions the road should be kept unobstructed and signage should be used to alert snowmobilers to hauling activities.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- According to the Bayfield County Access management plan the existing roads within this sale are open to highway vehicle use. Upon completion of the timber sale these roads will be left open unless otherwise directed by the sale administrator.
