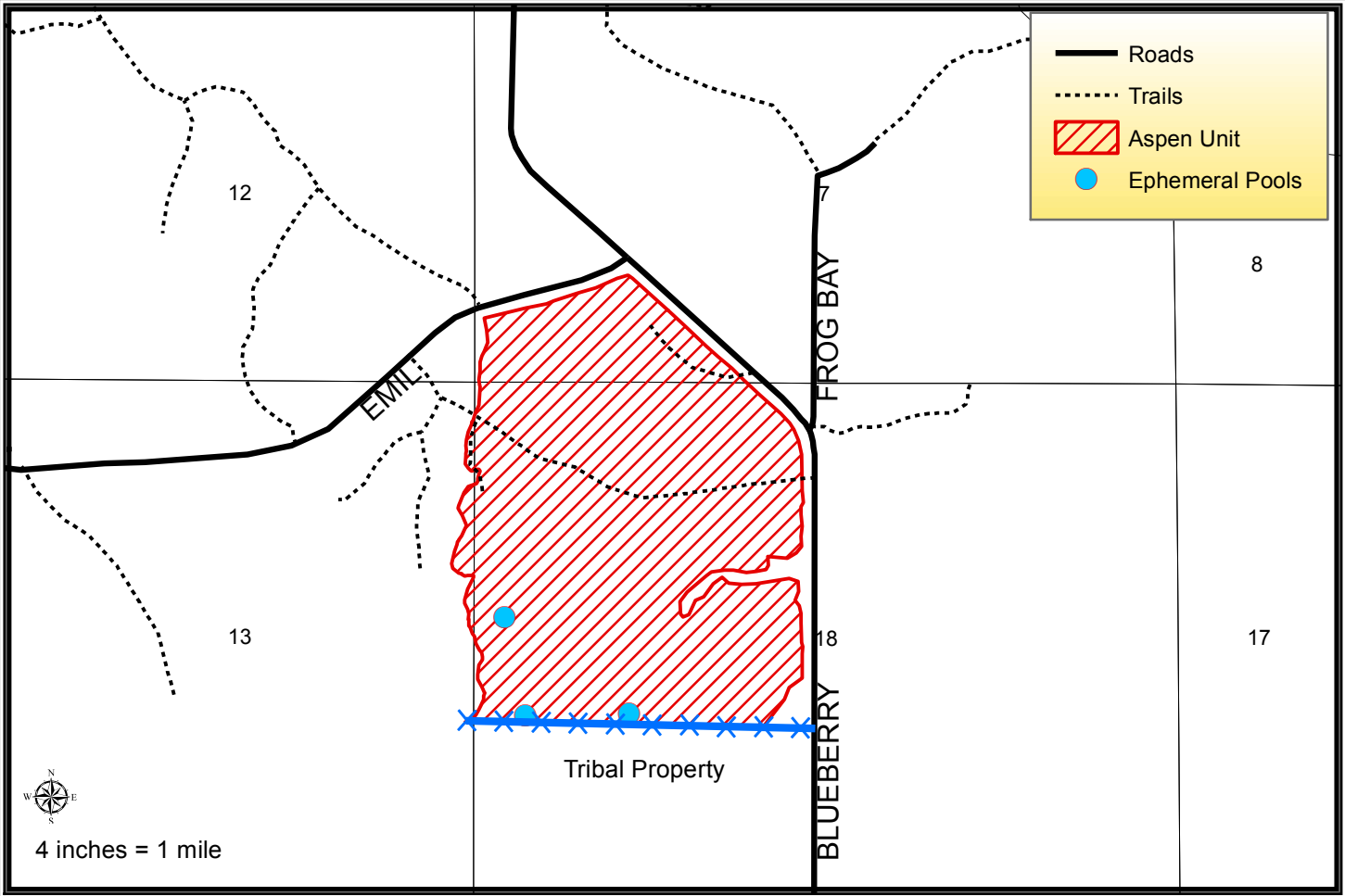

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a clearcut being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries consist of red line around the timber sale boundary and around ephemeral pools and blue line against tribal property.
- No hauling is allowed on Blueberry road.
- No equipment or felled trees may cross the blue paint line. This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
- There is a 50ft no cut buffer along Emil and Blueberry road marked out in red paint. Sale access will be off Emil road.
- Harvest all unmarked hardwood stems and merchantable spruce and balsam fir. Sever all non-merchantable hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater except leave all oak less than 4" dbh.
- Leave all purple marked hardwood and all conifers except merchantable spruce and fir.
- This sale includes 3-5 trees that are purple painted with a large X on either side and ringed with purple at 5 ft. Operator must fell and leave all trees marked in this fashion. Purple marked trees should be cut just above the 5 ft. purple painted ring and should lie as close to the high stump as possible. These trees will create ruffed grouse drumming habitat.
- Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
