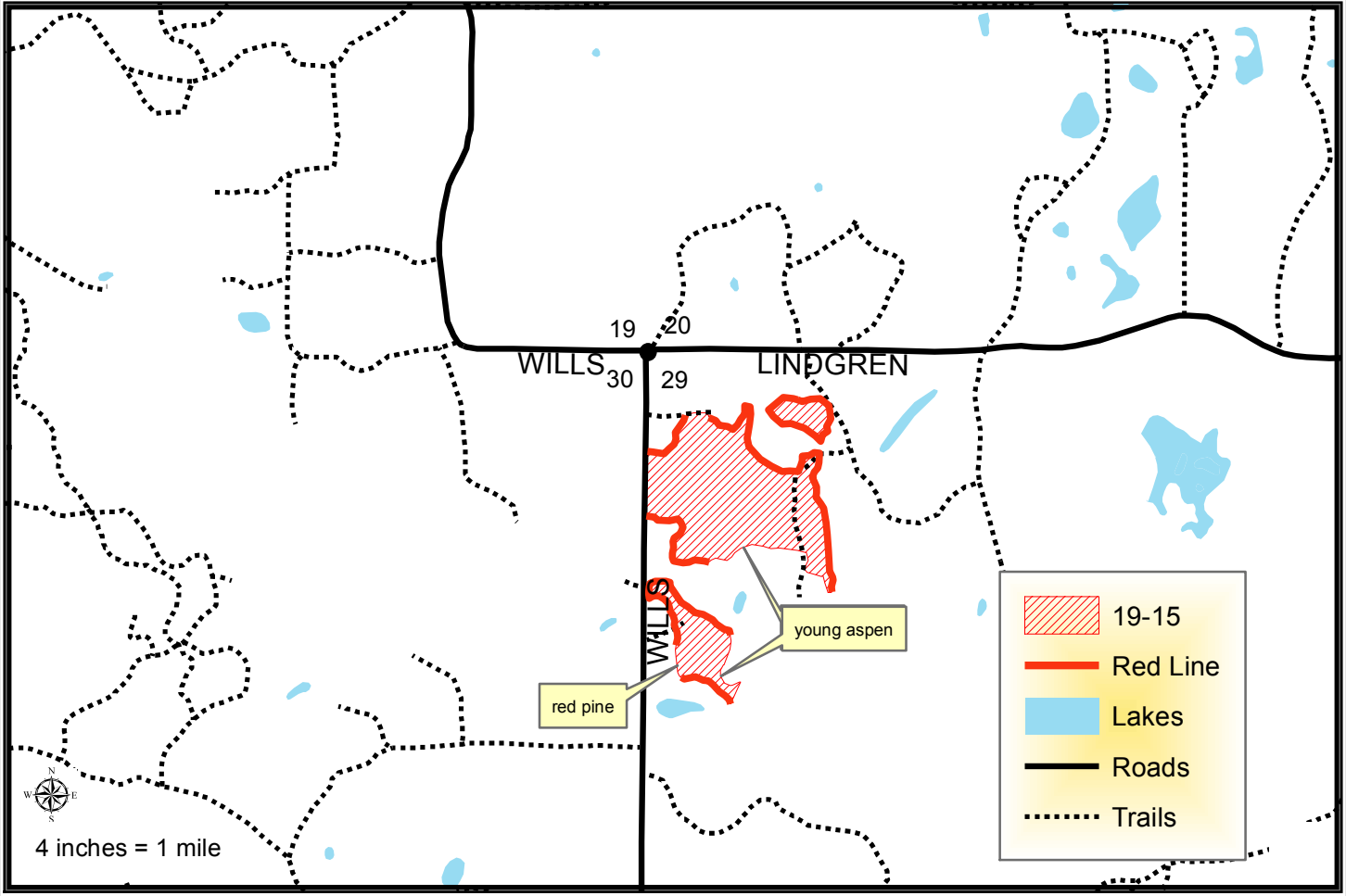

**Harvest Requirements:**

- Sale is an overstory removal being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- Harvest all merchantable timber except red pine and purple-marked oak.
- Damage to existing regeneration should be minimized.
- Sale boundaries are painted red line or abrupt changes in timber type (young aspen).
- No cavity trees were intentionally designated for harvest. All snags that do not pose a safety hazard will be left.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- There are numerous kegs/wetlands scattered throughout the sale. The majority of them are unmapped. Leave a 15-foot, no cut filter strip around any wetland/keg. No equipment or felled trees are allowed in the no-cut strip.
- The sale is restricted to short wood logging. Bayfield County may, at its discretion, allow pole skidding if the purchaser can demonstrate that it can be done without causing damage to existing regeneration.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
