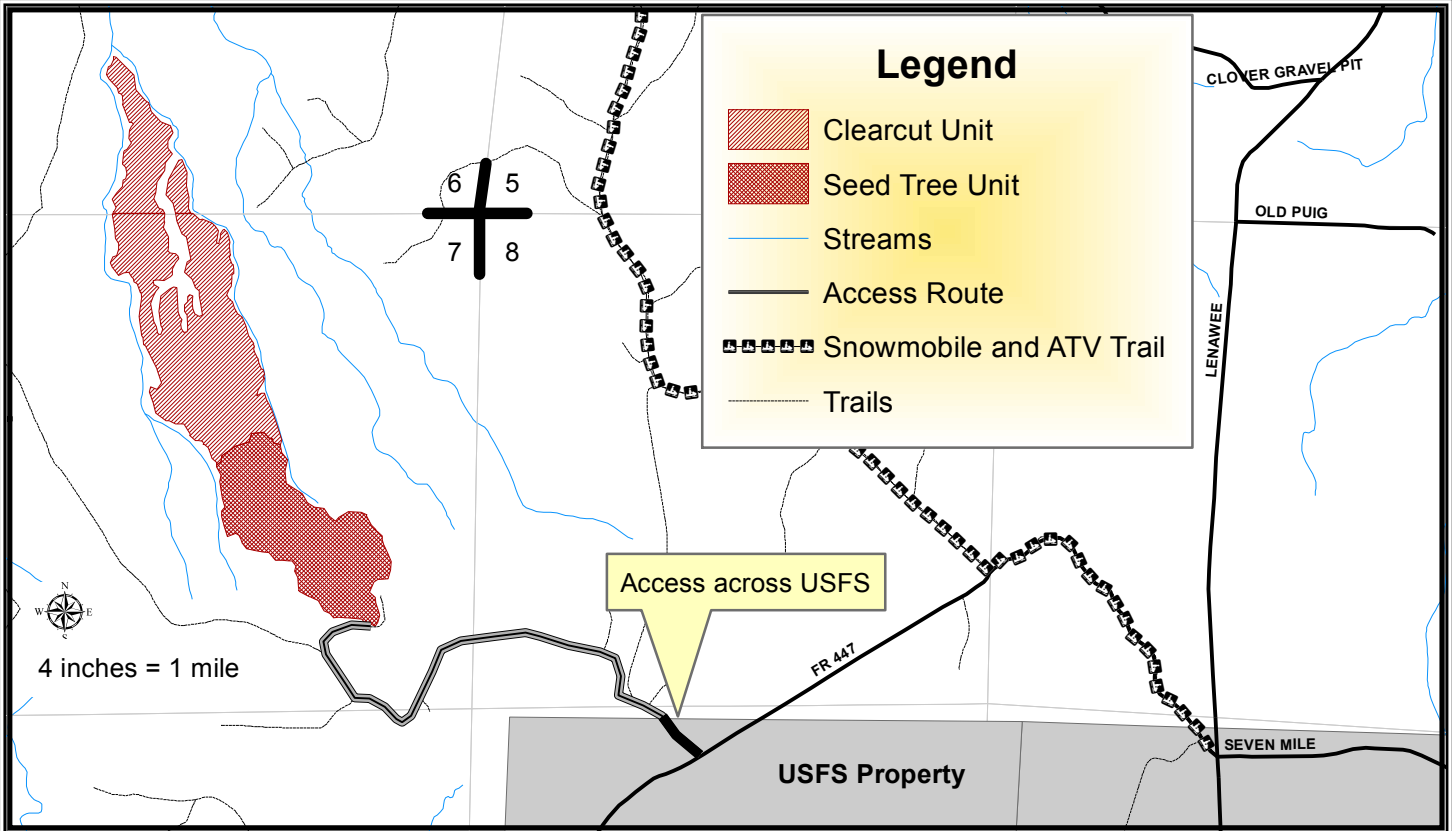

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- **Contractor must contact the County at least 3 weeks prior to moving into the sale to allow the County time to secure final access across USFS property.**
- The primary haul route utilizes a portion of the ATV trail. Excessive damage (beyond normal wear and tear) to the ATV trail, as determined by Bayfield County, will not be tolerated. If Bayfield County determines excessive damage has occurred, the Contractor may be held responsible for a portion or all of the repair. The County and Contractor must communicate on a regular basis to ensure issues are addressed in a timely manner and the ATV trail remains in a safe and acceptable condition.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must insure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line or noticeable change in timber type.
- Clearcut Unit: Leave all conifer except merchantable balsam fir and spruce. Harvest all other merchantable trees and sever all hardwood stems 2" and greater.
- Seed Tree Unit: Leave all purple marked trees and all conifer except merchantable balsam fir and spruce. Harvest all other merchantable trees and sever all hardwood stems 2" and greater.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- In the clearcut unit, sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen unless written permission is granted by Bayfield County.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
