In 2021, Bayfield County applied for and received \$827,000 in funds for three Community Development Block Grants for COVID-19 prevention and recovery for Bayfield County residents. Funds will be spent in 2021 and 2022.

**Funding went to three projects:**

- Rental/Mortgage/Utility Assistance for Low-to-Moderate Income (LMI) Individual in Bayfield County. Individuals could receive up to \$5,000 over a period of six months. A total of \$200,000 is available.
- Business Assistance Grants for business with Low-to-Moderate income employees or that are owned by someone who is LMI. Applicants may receive up to \$10,000 to cover COVID-19 related losses. A total of \$367,000 is available.
- The final project allocated \$260,000 in funds to assist the Northern Lights Nursing Home with HVAC improvements that would help address faulty HVAC equipment in the facility.

The Northwest Regional Planning Commission has been instrumental throughout the process by assisting interested citizens complete applications and by assisting Bayfield County in administering funds.
