

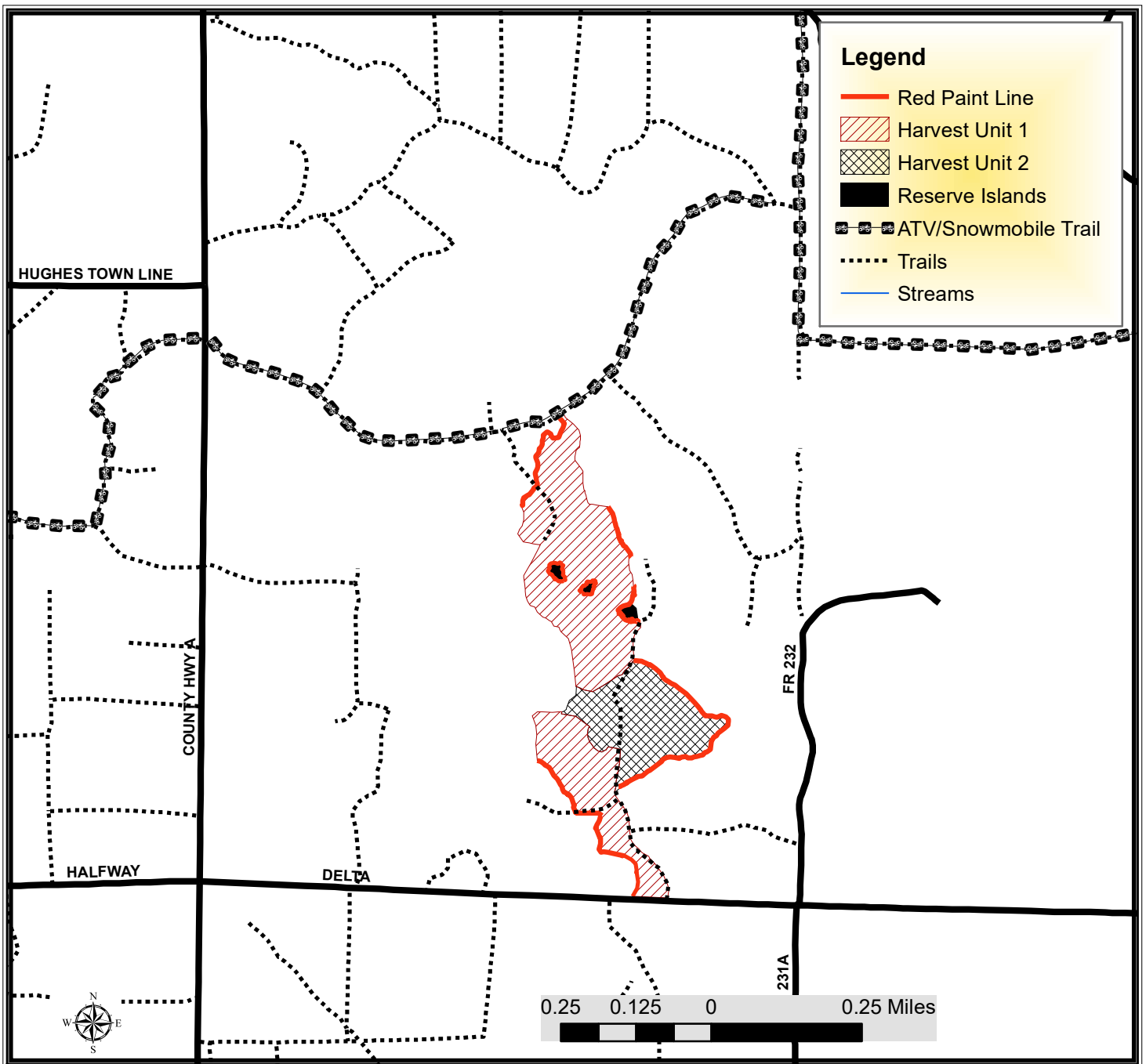

TRACT 47-21 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

- Harvest unit 1 has a coppice prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft².
- Harvest unit 2 has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft²

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

- In unit 1, harvest all hardwood stems 2" and greater and all jack pine.
- In unit 2, harvest all stems 2" and greater
- In unit 1, leave all conifer, except jack pine.

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- No skidding or hauling will be allowed on the ATV/Snowmobile trail indicated on the map.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

E. OTHER:

- To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
