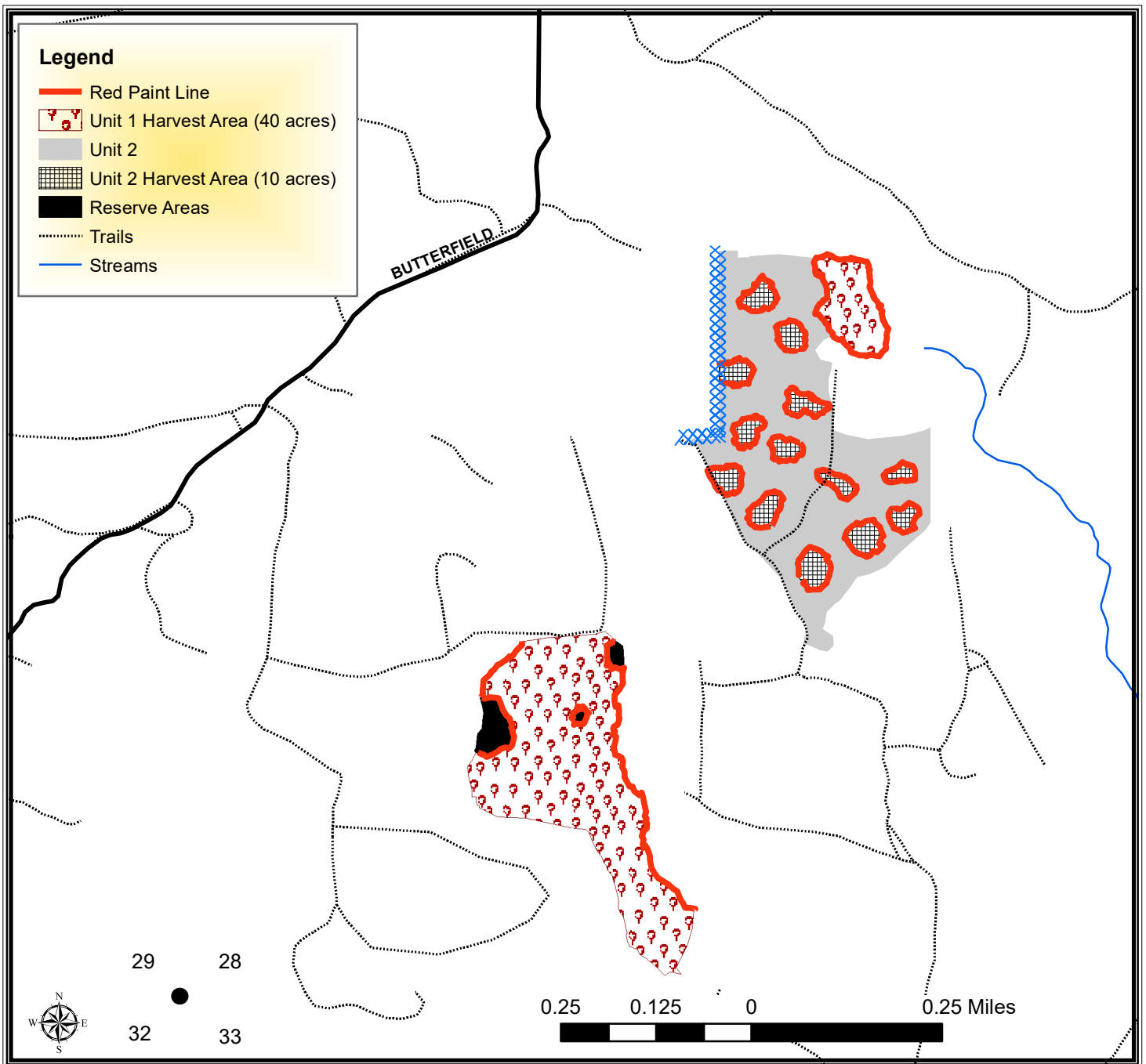

TRACT 49-21 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

- Harvest unit 1 has a coppice with reserves prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 14 ft².
- Harvest unit 2 has a northern hardwood patch harvest prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 116 ft².

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

- In unit 1, harvest all hardwood stems 2" and greater.
- In unit 2, harvest all hardwoods stems 2" and greater within each harvest patch. Harvest patch boundaries are marked with red paint.
- In units 1 and 2, leave all conifer.

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- In unit 2 and the small portion of unit 1, sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen or in exceptionally dry conditions, as determined by the county. (30% of harvest area)
- The blue paint line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
- Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops (≤4" diameter) will not be allowed.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- Butterfield Road is a dogsled trail. a) When snow is on the ground, maintain a packed snow base on the dog sled trail. b) When snow is on the ground, do not block intersections with snowbanks or berms after plowing. c) on the weekend of the Apostle Islands Sled Dog Race, no hauling will be permitted on any trails used by the race during Saturday or Sunday mornings, as determined by the sale administrator.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

E. OTHER:

- To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
