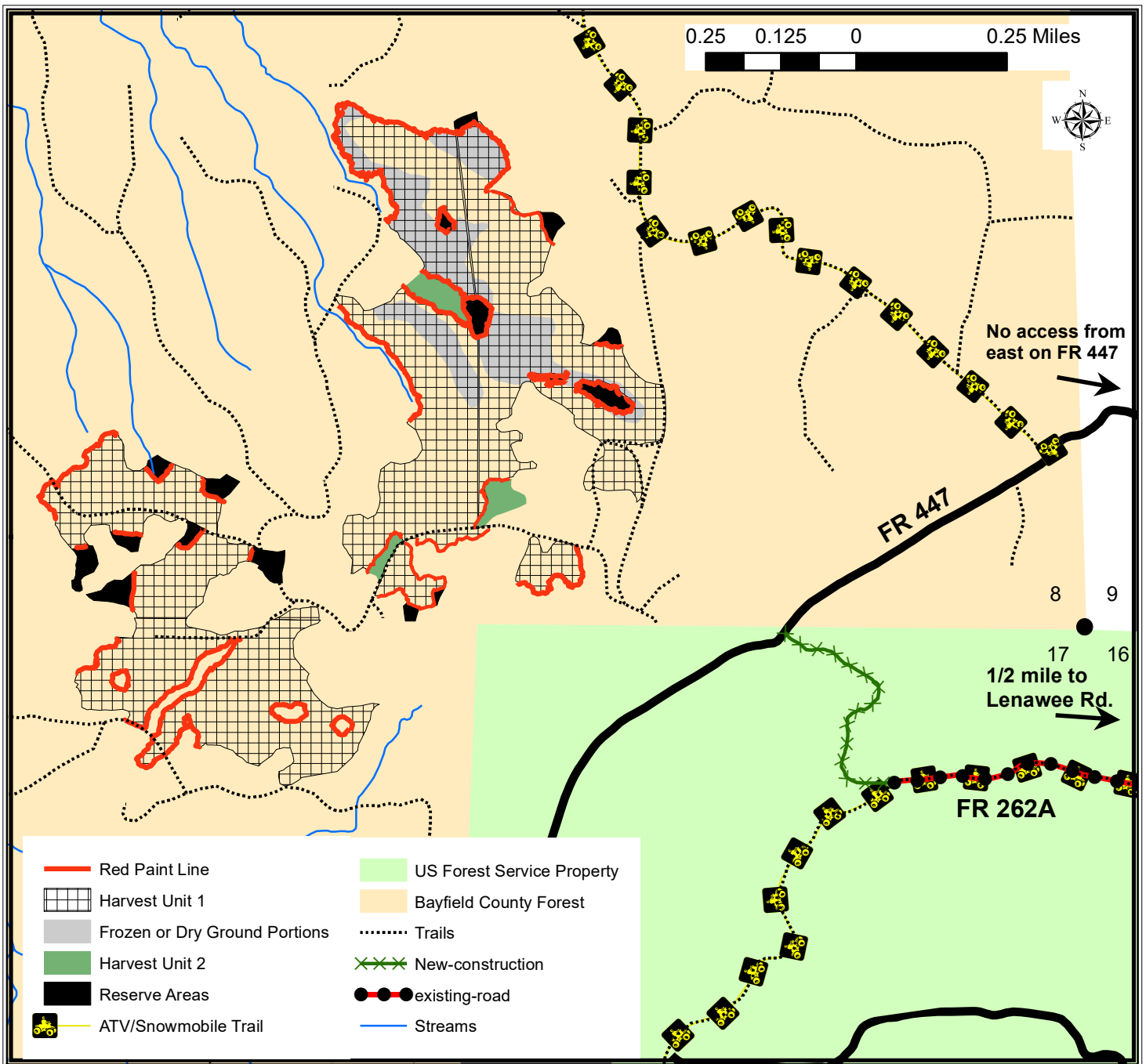

## TRACT 11-22 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

### A. PRESCRIPTION:

- Harvest unit 1 has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 2 ft<sup>2</sup>.
- Harvest unit 2 has a thinning prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 90 ft<sup>2</sup>.

### B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

- In unit 1, harvest all hardwood stems 2" and greater.
- In unit 2, harvest all aspen, birch, and orange marked trees.
- In units 1 and 2, leave all conifer.

### C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, trails, or a noticeable change in timber type.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.

### D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- A portion of the access route utilizes an ATV/snowmobile trail. During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles or ATVs. Avoid damage to signs and trail markers.
- The primary haul route utilizes a portion of the ATV trail. Excessive damage (beyond normal wear and tear) to the ATV trail, as determined by the county, will not be tolerated. If Bayfield County determines excessive damage has occurred, the Contractor may be held responsible for a portion or all of the repair. The County and Contractor must communicate on a regular basis to ensure issues are addressed in a timely manner and the ATV trail remains in a safe and acceptable condition.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

### E. OTHER:

- Contractor will be responsible for improvement/construction of approximately 1.25 miles of road (See attached Road Project Map Tract #11-22)**
- This sale will be sold as a **three (3) year contract**. Contract extensions are not guaranteed.
- In 2018, oak was officially confirmed in Bayfield County. Currently, this timber sale is located more than six miles away from the closest known infected tree. However, over the duration of this contract, additional infections could be discovered. If, over the duration of this contract, including extensions, oak wilt is officially confirmed within a six mile radius of this timber sale, as determined by the county, the following seasonal restriction will be applied: no harvesting operations will be allowed between April 15<sup>th</sup> (or as otherwise determined by the county) and July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
