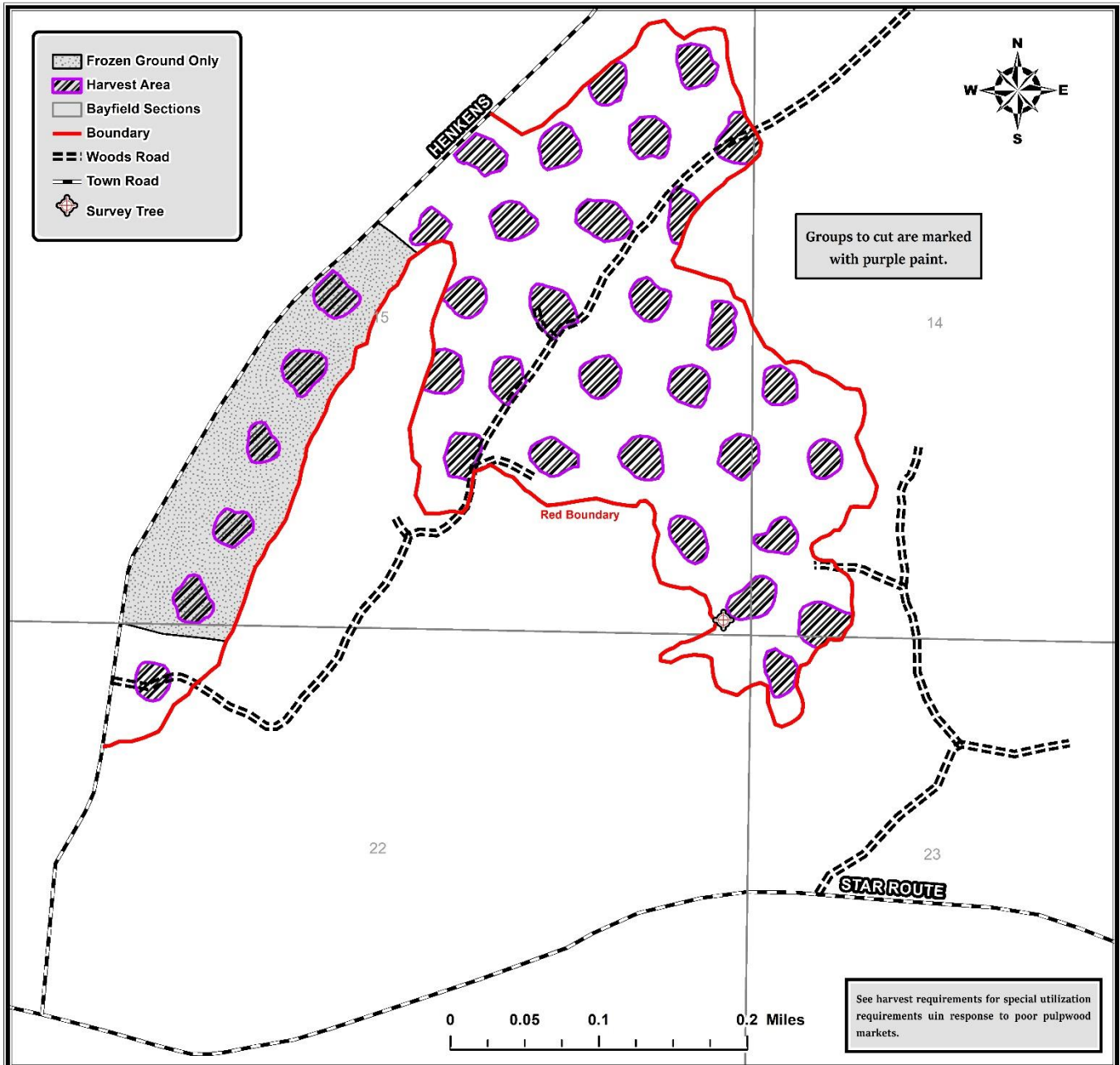

TRACT 14-23 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

- A. Group Selection - The designated harvest area will be a group selection harvest containing 35 - ½ acre gaps.

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

- **Group Selection** - Cut all trees 2" and greater in diameter in marked gaps:
 - Gaps are marked with purple paint. A horizontal slash faces the inside of the gap. A dot on each side of the tree faces the next marked tree.
 - Operational trees will need to be removed to create trails between gaps. No sawlog trees should be cut as operational trees.
 - Do not cut any dead snags that do not pose a safety hazard.

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS and SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- Sale boundaries red paint lines as indicated on map. Stand boundaries that do not have red line are adjacent to stands that have a definite change in the cover type and age or separated by a road or trail. Gaps are marked with purple paint.
- In 2018, oak wilt was officially confirmed in Bayfield County. Currently, this timber sale is located more than six miles away from the closest known infected tree. However, over the duration of this contract, additional infections could be discovered. If, over the duration of this contract, including extensions, oak wilt is officially confirmed within a six-mile radius of this timber sale, as determined by the county, the following seasonal restriction will be applied: no harvesting operations will be allowed between April 15 (or as otherwise determined by the county) and July 15.
- Henkens Road is an authorized atv/snowmobile route. Signage will be needed.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

E. OTHER:

1. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
2. Utilization specification is to a 4" top. However, if the County determines that pulpwood markets continue to be very poor at the time of harvest the County will sign a contract amendment with the purchaser changing the utilization specification to a 5" top for selected species. When determining condition of the market, the County will pay attention to the amount of wood being purchased by the mills in Wisconsin Rapids and any other significant shifts in wood demand.
3. Do not damage or destroy any survey monuments. Survey trees are marked in red paint. These trees are marked on the map for avoidance.
