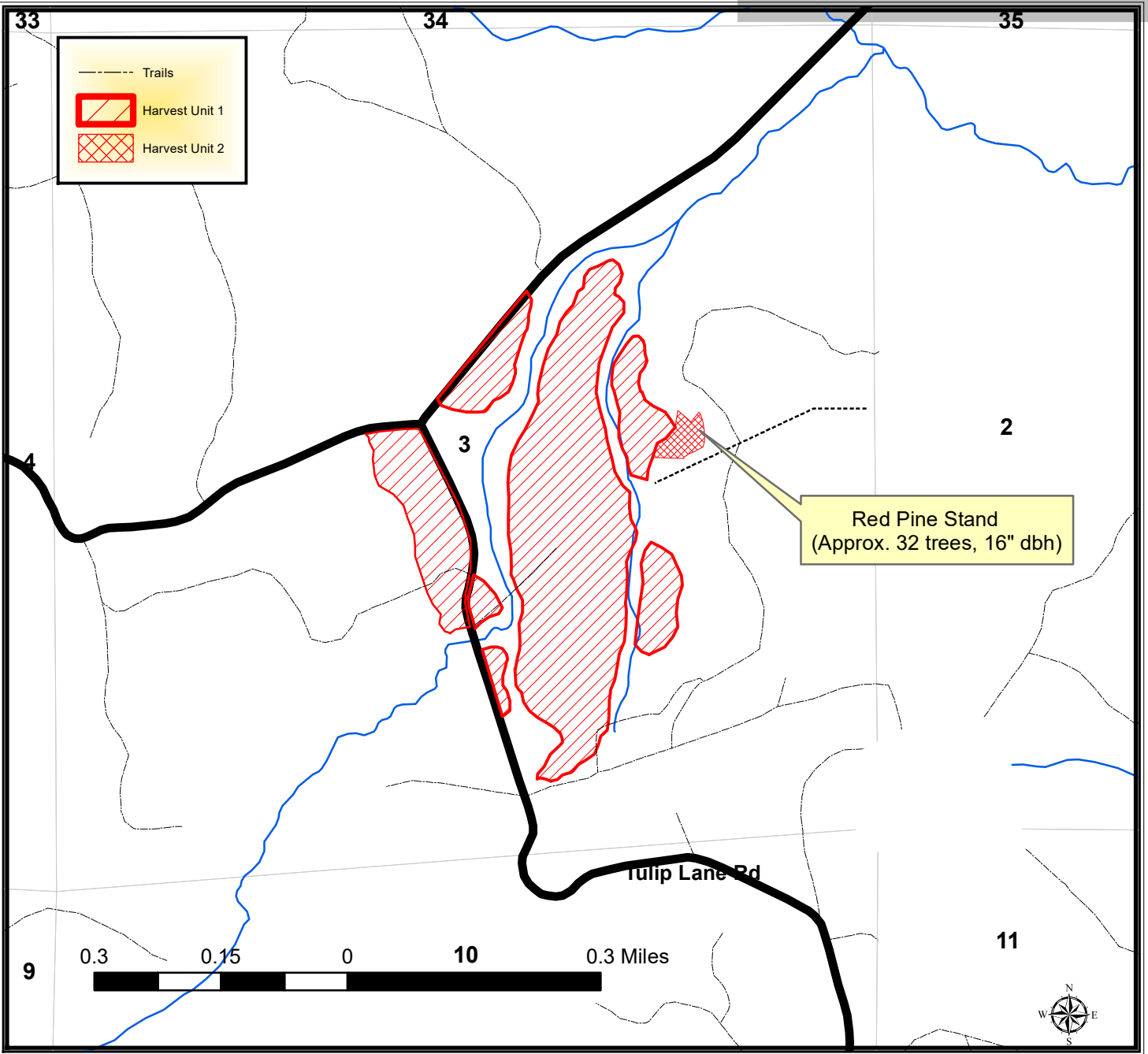

TRACT 26-23 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

- Harvest unit 1 has a coppice harvest prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 15 sq. ft.
- Harvest Unit 2 has a thinning prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 110 sq. ft.

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

- Harvest unit 1: Harvest all hardwood 2" and greater. Harvest all white spruce and jack pine. Leave all fir, cedar, hemlock, red and white pine. Leave all purple painted trees.
- Harvest Unit 2: Harvest all orange painted trees. Approx. 30-35 trees with an avg. diameter of 16".
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.

C. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- Access is off Van Stone and Little Sioux road.

D. OTHER:

- Red paint line borders the entire timber sale.
- To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
