### BAYFIELD COUNTY LOCAL GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP, 2023-2024

**WHAT:** Local Government Scholarship Program, 2023-2024

**FOR:** High School Seniors

**ELIGIBILITY:** Resident of Bayfield County in their senior year of High School

**AMOUNT:** Up to four \$500 Scholarships

**GOAL:** Encourage high school seniors to learn about and participate in local government through meeting attendance and essay writing.

#### QUALIFIERS:

- Between November 14, 2023 and April 11, 2024 applicants will attend a municipal (City, Town, Village or Tribal) meeting AND one county board meeting.
- Applicant will speak briefly at both meetings during public comment informing the board of their intent to apply for this scholarship, including: their name, school, interest they may have in local government and their reason for applying for the scholarship.
- On or before April 11, 2024, the applicant will submit a one-page essay on:
  - **What the difference is between a municipal board, tribal council, and county board supervisor member.**
  - **The number of County Board Supervisors in Bayfield County, who they represent, and who is your district supervisor.**
  - **Your thoughts on a topic addressed by the Bayfield County Board in 2023.**

**JUDGES:** Bayfield County Board will make awards in May of 2024.

**AWARD:** The scholarship announcement will be distributed at the school or group's Awards Ceremony by a Bayfield County Board Member or designee. A check will be written to the school to be transferred to the student.
